CANNED MILKESITUATION STEADY TO FIRM AS STOCKS INCREASE

THE CONDENSED AND EVAPORATED MILK MARKETS CONTINUE IN A FAVORABLE POSITION ON INTO JULY. PERHAPS SOME OF THE FIRMNESS OF LATE JUNE HAS BEEN SOMEWHAT TEMPERED, BUT THE GENERAL SITUATION IS FULLY STEADY TO FIRM. DEMAND HAS BEEN GOOD, THE RATHER PROLONGED AND GENERAL PERIODS OF HOT WEATHER CONTRIBUTING TO THIS. AT THE SAME TIME PRODUCTION HAS NOT BEEN AS GREAT AS A YEAR AGO. IN GENERAL IT MAY BE SAID THAT THE MARKET POSITION ON THE CANNED MILKS IS WELL IN LINE WITH THE GENERAL DAIRY MARKET TRENDS. IT IS REPORTED THAT PRICES HAVE WORKED TO SLIGHTLY HIGHER LEVELS, AND THAT THESE HIGHER PRICES HAVE BEEN MET, FOR THE MOST PART, WITH NO RESTRICTION OF BUYING.

MANUFACTURER'S STOCKS ON JULY I SHOW A HEAVY INCREASE OVER THE PREVIOU MONTH, INCREASING FROM 158,647,986 PQUNDS TO 243,285,982 POUNDS. WHILE THIS INCREASE IS LARGER THAN THE AVERAGE ONE FOR THIS PERIOD, IT IS NOT MATERIALLY GREATER THAN THE CHANGE THAT OF COURRED IN 1927. THE FIVE YEAR AVERAGE FOR JULY I IS 224,982,810 POUNDS, SO IT MAY BE SEEN THAT STOCKS NOW ARE APPRECIABLY IN EXCESS OF THIS AVERAGE WHEREAS A MONTH AGO STOCKS WER LOWER THAN THE AVERAGE. THE GENERAL FEELING IS THAT THE GENERAL TREND OF THE INDUSTRY IS TOWARD HEAVIER RESERVE TO MEET THE CONSTANTLY WIDENING DUTLET

AS MENTIONED ABOVE, PRODUCTION DURING JUNE FELL SHORT OF A YEAR EARLIER. THIS DECREASE AMOUNTED TO ABOUT 2% AND THE DECREASE SINCE THE FIRST OF THE YEAR COMPARED WITH THE SAME PERIOD OF 1927 SHOWS A REDUCTION OF ABOUT THE SAME AMOUNT. THIS DECREASE IS IN NO WAY PECULIAR TO THE CANNED MILK MARKET, FOR IT IS SEEN THROUGHOUT THE DAIRY PRODUCTS FIELD, AND APPEARS TO BE CAUSED TO CONSIDERABLE EXTENT BY RATHER UNFAVORABLE PASTURE CONDITIONS. SUCH INFORMATION AS IS AVAILABLE SERVES TO INDICATE THAT THE TENDENCY FOR PRODUCTION TO FALL
