EVAPORATED MILK STEADIER - CONDENSED MILK EASIER

THE PRODUCTION OF CONDENSED AND EVAPORATED MILK DURING SEPTEMBER HAS FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE MARCH SHOWED A DECREASE WHEN COMPARED WITH THE PRO-DUCTION FOR THE CORRESPONDING PERIOD LAST YEAR. A COMPARISON OF THE OUTPUT OF PRICES ANNOUNCED BY EVAPORATED MILK FIRMS REPORTING TO THE DEPARTMENT POINTS TO AN APPARENT DECREASE OF APPROXIMATELY 3 PER CENT IN THE TOTAL MANUFACTURE OF THESE COMMODITIES DURING LAST MONTH OVER THE SAME MONTH IN 1929.

OCTOBER | STOCKS OF 309,963,000 POUNDS STILL SHOW THE ACCUMULATIVE EFFECT OF THE HEAVY SUMMER PRODUCTION, AND ON THAT DATE WERE 48 PER CENT LARGER THAN A YEAR AGO. THE REDUCTION, HOWEVER, OF 25,000,000 POUNDS (MOST OF THE REDUCTION BEING ON EVAPORATED CASE GOODS) FROM THE RESERVES ON HAND ON SEPTEMBER | COMPARES QUITE FAVORABLY WITH A REDUCTION OF

1,000,000 POUNDS IN 1928 AND A 5 YEAR AVERAGE REDUCTION OF AROUND 20,000,000 POUNDS. THIS FAIRLY HEAVY DECREASE IN MANUFACTURERS ON AUGUST 12, AND WHICH WERE MADE FOR THE PURPOSE OF MOVING SUPPLIES THAT HAD BECOME BURDENSOME.

MARKET CONDITIONS ON EVAPORATED MILK FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER WERE GENERALLY UNSETTLED, WITH BUYERS DISPOSED TO PURCHASE ONLY FOR CURRENT REQUIREMENTS.
STOCKS, HOWEVER, WERE REDUCED AROUND
23,000,000 POUNDS, SO THAT DURING THE
PRESENT MONTH THE TRADE REPORTS A
TENDENCY FOR THE MARKET ON THIS COMMODITY
TO SHOW SOME SLIGHT RECOVERY OF ITS FORMER STRENGTH, AND AT THIS WRITING IT MAY BE CONSIDERED AS STEADY, WITH

MANUFACTURERS! TOTAL STOCKS OF CONDENSED AND EVAPORATED MILK

SUPPLIES AMPLE TO A FAIR DEMAND.

THE MARKET ON SWEETENED CONDENSED BULK GOODS HAS ASSUMED AN EASIER TONE THAN INDICATED AT THE TIME OF THE PRECEDING REPORT. STOCKS ON OCTOBER I SHOWED A DECREASE OF ONLY 1,300,000 POUNDS OVER THE SEPTEMBER 1 HOLDINGS. REPORTED WHOLESALE PRICES ON OCTOBER |

WERE GIVEN AS 2 CENTS PER CWT. LOWER ON CONDENSED UNSKIMMED AND 8 CENTS PER CWT. LOWER ON CONDENSED SKIMMED. PRODUCTION IS BEING FAIRLY WELL MAINTAINED, ALTHOUGH SHOWING SLIGHTLY MORE THAN THE NORMAL SEASONAL DECLINE AS A RESULT OF THE COMPARATIVE SHORTAGE OF FLUID MILK IN SOME OF THE MOST IMPORTANT WHOLE MILK SHEDS.
