EVAPORATED MILK MARKETS ABOUT STEADY - PRODUCTION CONTINUES TO DECLINE

ALTHOUGH SOMEWHAT EASIER IN SOME SECTIONS, NOVEMBER EVAPORATED MILK MARKETS HELD GENERALLY UNCHANGED FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH, ACCORDING TO THE U.S. BUREAU OF AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS. THE TONE WAS ABOUT STEADY AND, EXCEPT FOR A SLIGHT DECLINE ON LESSER KNOWN BRANDS IN SOME QUARTERS, WHOLESALE PRICES REMAINED GENERALLY UNCHANGED. RETAIL PRICES ALSO CONTINUED UNUSUALLY LOW, WITH TALL CANS IN EASTERN MARKETS SELLING BELOW 5 CENTS PER CAN IN COMPETITION WITH LOW PRICED FLUID MILK. EVEN AT THESE LOW PRICES, HOWEVER, CONSUMPTION WAS APPARENTLY BELOW A YEAR AGO AND ALSO LIGHTER THAN DURING THE SEVERAL PREVIOUS MONTHS.

EVAPORATED MILK PRODUCTION IN NOVEMBER IS SAID TO HAVE CONTINUED TO DECLINE, ACCORDING TO THE MOST RELIABLE INFORMATION AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME. IN NOVEMBER LAST YEAR, THE REDUCTION FROM THE OCTOBER MAKE AMOUNTED TO 14.2 PER CENT, IN 1930 TO 11.0 PER CENT, IN 1929 TO 15.3 PER CENT, AND IN 1928 TO 22.5 PER CENT. However, NOT ONLY HAS NOVEMBER PRODUCTION CONTINUED TO DECLINE, BUT THIS DECLINE IS ESTIMATED AS GREATER THAN A YEAR AGO WITH THE MAKE ABOUT EQUAL TO OR POSSIBLY LIGHTER THAN IN NOVEMBER, 1931. THIS HAS OCCURRED DESPITE THE FACT THAT PRODUCTION AS RECENTLY AS AUGUST WAS STILL 38.5 PER CENT HEAVIER THAN DURING THAT

MONTH A YEAR EARLIER. THE AVERAGE NOVEMBER PRICE PAID PRODUCERS THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES FOR 3.5 PER CENT MILK, CELIVERED CONDENSERIES, WAS 86 CENTS PER OWT., CR' THE SAME AS DURING DOTDER, BUT THE PRICE DIFFERENTIAL, UNDER THE SAME MONTH A YEAR AGO, WIDENED FROM 36 CENTS PER CWT. IN OCTOBER TO 37 CENTS IN ... NOVEMBER.

DURING OCTOBER, THE MOST RECENT MONTH FOR WHICH DEFINITE COMPARATIVE FIGURES ARE AVAILABLE, EVAPORATED MILK PRODUCTION WAS 4.9 PER CENT HEAVIER THAN DURING THE SAME MONTH IN 1931, BUT WAS 5.8 PER CENT LIGHTER THAN DURING THE . PREVIOUS MONTH. THIS RELATIVELY SHARP REDUCTION IN DUTPUT FROM SEPTEMBER TO OCTOBER IS IN CONTRAST TO AN 18.1 PER CENT INCREASE IN 1931, AND A 6.6 PER CENT INCREASE IN 1930. WHILE THE OUTPUT, IN COMPARISON WITH A YEAR AGO, WAS 32.3 PER CENT HEAVIER IN SEPTEMBER THAN THE SAME MONTH IN 1931, PRODUCTION WAS BUT 4.9 PER CENT HEAVIER IN OCTOBER. THE RELATIVELY LIGHT PRODUCTION OF EVAPORATED MILK IN OCTOBER THIS YEAR IN COMPARISON WITH EARLIER MONTHS, REFLECTS A SHARP DECLINE III DAILY MILK PURCHASES PER PRODUCER BY COMDENSERS. THE DAILY AVERAGE IN SEPTEMBER, WAS 2.6 PER CENT HEAVIER -THAN A YEAR A. S. BUT IN OCTOBER WAS 6.6 PER CENT LIGHTER. THE LIGHTER PRO-DUCTION REFLECTED BY THESE FIGURES WAS DUE PRIMARILY TO LESS FAVORABLE FALL PASTURES IN THE MAJOR EVAPORATED MILK PRODUCING SECTIONS THIS YEAR THAN LAST YEAR, BUT A LIGHTER FEEDING OF CONDENTRATES. AND MORE UNFAVORABLE CLIMATIO CONDITIONS

ALSO PLAYED A PART. A SHARPER DECREASE IN THE NUMBER OF PRODUCERS DELIVERING MILK TO CONDENSERIES ALSO CONTRIBUTED TO THE RELATIVELY SHARP DECREATE IN THE MAKE. DESPITE THE SHARPLY CURTAILED PRODUCTION, HOWEVER, THE MAKE OF EVAPORATED MILK IN OCTOBER WAS STILL 3.1 PER CENT HEAVIER THAN THE 5-YEAR AVERAGE.

THE GREATER-THAN-NORMAL SEASONAL DECREASE IN PRODUCTION, IN COMBINATION WITH THE RELATIVELY WELL MAINTAINED CONSUMPTION DEMAND DURING OCTOBER RESULTED IN RATHER HEAVY REDUCTIONS IN STOCKS. SUPPLIES OF EVAPORATED MILK ON NOVEMBER 1, AS A RESULT, WERE BUT 12.2 PER CENT HEAVIER THAN ON THE SAME DATE A YEAR AGO, AND WERE 24.6 PER CENT LIGHTER THAN THE 5-YEAR AVERAGE, THIS DESPITE THE FACT THAT A MONTH EARLIER THE RESPECTIVE PERCENTAGES WERE 25.0 AND ILL.3. THE REQUESTION IN STOCKS DURING 11.3. THE REDUCTION IN STOCKS DURING DOTOBER -AMOUNTED TO 17.0 PER CENT.

CONDENSED MILK MARKETS IN NOVEMBER CONTINUED ABOUT STEADY WITH TRADING QUIET. PRODUCTION, IN OCTOBER, PROVED 30.3 PER CENT LIGHTER THAN DURING THE SAME MONTH IN 1931, BUT SHOWED A SEASONAL INCREASE OF 9.2 PER CENT FROM THE MAKE OF THE PREVIOUS MONTH. THE STOCKS SITUATION REMAINED GENERALLY UNCHANGED FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH WITH NOVEMBER | SUPPLIES 11.1 PER CENTILIBHTER THAN ON THE SAME DATE A YEAR A30, AND 45.0 PER DENT LIGHTER THAN THE 5-YEAR AVERAGE. THE REDUCTION IN STOCKS DURING COTOBER AMOUNTED TO 15.6 PER CENT.
