### STOCKS OF EVAPORATED MILK BELOW AVERAGE - MARKETING AGREEMENT PRICES UNCHANGED

STOCKS OF EVAPORATED MILK IN THE HANDS OF MANUFACTURERS ON AUGUST 1, AS REPORTED TO THE U.S. BUREAU OF AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS, WERE CONSIDERABLY BELOW AVERAGE, BUT THERE WAS AN INCREASE IN STOCKS OVER THOSE OF JULY I WHICH AMOUNT-ED TO 50,000,000 POUNDS, COMPARED WITH AN AVERAGE INCREASE OF BUT 26,000,000 POUNDS. OFFSETTING THIS, HOWEVER, IS THE FACT THAT THE AUGUST | STOCKS, TOTALING 203,835,000 POUNDS, WERE 31,000,000 POUNDS LESS THAN THE AUGUST | FIVE-YEAR THIS RELATIONSHIP, TOGETHER WITH PRODUCTION THIS SEASON RUNNING MATERIALLY BELOW LAST YEAR, PARTLY ACCOUNTS FOR THE STEADY TO FIRM MARKET ACCOUNTS FOR THE STEADY TO FIRM MARKET WHICH CONTINUES TO PREVAIL. REGARDLESS OF A GENERAL FALLING OFF OF DAIRY PRODUCTION, EVAPORATED MILK DID SHOW AN INCREASE IN JULY OF 102 MILLION POUNDS OVER A YEAR EARLIER, BUT IN ALL OTHER MONTHS OF 1934, THE YEAR TO YEAR COMPARISONS SHOWED DECREASES, WITH THE RESULT THAT FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR TO AUGUST 1. FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR TO AUGUST 1934 PRODUCTION WAS 98 MILLION POUNDS LESS THAN THE CORRESPONDING PERLOP OF 1933. THERE WAS A DECREASE OF  $24^{1}_{2}$ MILLION POUNDS UNDER 1933 PRODUCTION DURING THE FLUSH PRODUCTION PERIOD ALONE, MAY, JUNE, AND JULY.

TRADE DUTPUT OF EVAPORATED MILK EXCEEDED THAT OF 1933 EARLY IN THE YEAR, AND AGAIN IN JUNE, BUT DURING ALL OTHER MONTHS WAS LESS THAN LAST YEAR. FOR THE PERIOD, JANUARY TO JULY, INCLUSIVE, THERE WAS AN ESTIMATED DECREASE IN 1934 OF 60 MILLION POUNDS UNDER THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF 1933. SOME OF THE SIGNIFICANCE

OF THIS COMPARISON IS REMOVED, HOWEVER, WHEN IT IS RECOGNIZED THAT ESTIMATES OF MONTHLY TRADE OUTPUT DO NOT TAKE INTO ACCOUNT STOCKS HELD BY WHOLESALE GROCERS, DECAUSE OF A LACK OF DATA. THE LAST QUARTERLY REPORT OF WHOLESALE GROCERS! STOCKS, WHICH APPLIES TO JUNE 30, SHOWS THAT ON THAT DATE IN 1933, THIS CLASS OF DISTRIBUTORS WERE CARRYING STOCKS ALMOST DOUBLE THE AMOUNTS USUALLY HELD, AND ALMOST DOUBLE THE STOCKS HELD ON JUNE 30 THIS YEAR, THE AMOUNTS THIS YEAR BEING ABOUT AVERAGE. THUS, A LIGHTER TRADE OUTPUT IN 1934 MAY DE PARTLY ACCOUNTED FOR BY LIGHTER STOCKS CARRIED BY WHOLE—SALE GROCERS THIS YEAR. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE HEAVY MOVEMENT OF EVAPORATED MILK FROM MANUFACTURERS HANDS IN JUNE THIS YEAR MAY HAVE BEEN DUE TO WHOLESALE GROCERS STOCKING UP IN ANTICIPATION OF A PRICE INCREASE, SINCE ABOUT THAT TIME THERE WAS A PROPOSAL TO AMEND THE EVAPORATED MILK MARKETING AGREEMENT AND REMOVE THE EXISTING MAXIMUM WHOLESALE SELLING PRICE PROVISION. THIS AMENDMENT IS STILL PENDING.

AVERAGE WHOLESALE SELLING PRICES OF EVAPORATED CASE IN JULY WERE PRACTICALLY THE SAME AS IN JUNE. SOME PRICE SHADING WAS SAID TO-HAVE TAKEN PLACE, BUT THE VOLUME OF DUSINESS ON SUCH A BASIS WAS PROBABLY NOT LARGE IN RELATION TO TOTAL SALES.
