EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED MILK REPORT

_ JULY 1939

The production of evaporated milk (case goods) for June is estimated by the Agricultural Marketing Service at 265,586,000 pounds. This is 4 percent less than the estimated production of June last year but 12 percent more than the June average for the 5 years 1933-37. The January-June production is placed at 1,179,061,000 pounds. This is a decrease of 8,552,000 pounds, or 1 percent, from the production of the corresponding 6 months last year, but an increase of 174,524,000 pounds, or 17 percent, over the average production for the corresponding period in the 5 years 1933-37.

Production of condensed milk for June, both case and bulk goods, also was less than a year earlier, and less than the 5-year June average. The estimated output of 2,755,000 pounds of condensed milk (case goods) was 14 percent less than the estimated June production of last year and 44 percent less than the June 5-year average. The production of condensed milk (bulk goods) during June is estimated at 21,059,000 pounds, a decrease of 11 percent from the June production of last year and 9 percent from the 5-year June average.

Stocks of evaporated milk (case goods) held by manufacturers on July 1 totaled 292,322,000 pounds, the smallest July 1 stocks since July 1936. They were 48,000,000 pounds, or 17 percent, smaller than the stocks on July 1 last year, but 86,000,000 pounds, or 41 percent, larger than the 5-year (1933-37) July 1 average. The large increase indicated for the current year in comparison with the 5-year average is distorted to a considerable extent by the inclusion in the 5-year average of 3 years; i. e. 1936, 1934 and 1933, in which the midsummer stocks were unusually low.

The increase of manufacturers' supplies of evaporated milk (case goods) during June totaled 83,288,000 pounds. This increase is moderately less than the 89,000,000 pounds reported for July last year, but is much larger than the June average gain of 54,000,000 pounds for the years 1933-37.

The average wholesale selling price of evaporated milk of \$2.67 per case in June was 1 cent per case less than the average price paid in May. This is about the usual seasonal decrease in such prices from May to June, but it is 1 cent per case less than the decrease of last year. The average wholesale selling price of condensed milk (case goods) in June was \$4.80 per case, unchanged from the average price of the preceding month of this year and the same as that of the corresponding month last year.

The average price paid producers for milk delivered at condenseries during June was \$1.13 per cwt. for 3.5 percent milk. This is an increase of 3 cents per twt. over the price paid producers in May. The price being paid producers by condenseries is rapidly approaching that of last year for the corresponding months. In January the average price for that month was 33 cents per cwt. less than that of a year earlier, whereas in June it was only 2 cents per cwt. less. This difference is not attributed to any marked rise in prices this year but rather to a sharp ropping off in prices from January to June last year.




