EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED MILK REPORT

SEPTEMBER 1939

The output of evaporated milk, case goods, during August is estimated by the Agricultural Marketing Service to be 194,162,000 pounds. This is an increase of 3 percent over the production of August last year, and 17 percent over the 5-year (1933-37) average August production. For the first month since March current production has exceeded that of the corresponding month last year.

Production of evaporated milk, case goods, for the first eight months of 1939 is estimated at 1,597,000 pounds. This is about 3,000,000 pounds smaller than the production of the corresponding months of last year, but is an increase of 230,000,000 pounds, or 17 percent, over the 1933-37 average.

The estimated output of 2,461,000 pounds of condensed milk, case goods, was about 1/4 less than that of a year earlier, and only about 1/2 as much as the average August production for the years 1935-37. Production for the first eight months of 1939 is estimated at 23,824,000 pounds. This is a decrease of 23 percent from the production of the corresponding 8 months of last year, and 38 percent less than the 1933-37 average production.

Stocks of evaporated milk, case goods, held by manufacturers on September 1 totaled 355,095,000 pounds. This is a decrease of 15 percent from the 419,142,000 pounds reported on September 1 last year, but is an increase of 66 percent over the average September 1 stocks of 213,905,000 pounds reported for the years 1933-37.

Manufacturers' stocks of condensed milk, case goods, on September 1 totaled 8,001,000 pounds. This is a decrease of 19 percent from the September 1 stocks of last year, and 46 percent from the 5-year (1933-37) September 1 average. They are also the smallest September 1 stocks of record.

Prices paid producers for milk delivered at condenseries during August averaged \$1.18 per cwt, adjusted to 3.5 percent butterfat basis, compared with \$1.15 per cwt. a year earlier and \$1.52 per cwt. two years earlier. August is the fourth consecutive month for which the average price paid of milk delivered condenseries was higher than that of the preceding month. But it is the first month since December 1937 that the prices paid have averaged higher than that of the corresponding month in the preceding year.

The average wholesale selling price of evaporated milk, case goods, in August was \$2.68 per case of $48-14\frac{1}{2}$ oz. cans. This is unchanged from the average of July, but it is 3 cents per case less than August, 1938. It is also 10 cents per case less than the 1933-37 August average.

Apparently the increase in the August production of evaporated milk, case goods, was a reflection of the heavy milk production during August. Reports of crop correspondents to the Agricultural Marketing Service indicate that the seasonal decline in milk production during August was smaller than usual, and that on September 1 total milk production for the country as a whole again approached record levels for that time of the year.




