STOCKS OF EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED MILK HELD BY WHOLESALE GROCERS

(September 30, 1947)

Stocks of canned evaporated and condensed milk held by wholesale grocers on September 30, 1947 were both considerably larger than not only those at the end of June but also those of a year earlier, the Bureau of Agricultural Economics reports. While reported stocks of evaporated milk were larger than a year earlier, they were smaller than those of the same date in 1945. With the recent sharp increase in production of condensed milk, stocks held by reporting wholesale grocers on September 30, 1947 were the largest of record for any date since 1928.

Stocks of evaporated milk reported by 551 firms on September 30, 1947 totaled 41,940,000 pounds compared with 35,689,000 pounds on June 30 reported by 581 firms and 39,299,000 pounds on September 30, 1946 by 614 firms. Comparing stocks for firms which reported for both September 30 this year and last, a gain of 13 percent is indicated. Comparison on the same basis from June 30 to September 30, shows an increase of 21 percent. In terms of days' supply, wholesale grocers reporting to the Bureau estimated, on the basis of present rates of movement, that their September 30 stocks would last 32 days compared with 27 days in June and 28 days a year earlier. The seasonal gain of 5 days' supplies from June to September this year compares with a 6-day gain in 1946. The average gain during the quarter from June 30 to September 30 for the years 1941-45 was 3 days' supply.

Holdings of condensed milk by 551 firms on September 30, 1947 totaled 1,384,000 pounds while 614 firms reported 607,000 pounds a year earlier. Stocks of 542 firms who reported for both September 30 this year and last showed a gain of 129 percent. On the same basis, 537 firms showed an increase of 56 percent during the quarter from June to September this year.
