While the year-end stocks of evaporated and condensed milk held by wholesale grocers declined seasonally from September 30, holdings were sharply higher than a year earlier, the Bureau of Agricultural Toonomics reports.

Stocks of evaporated milk held by 501 wholesale grocers on December 31 totaled 34,007,000 pounds. Comparing holdings of 491 firms that reported for both September 30 and December 31, stocks were 33,650,000 pounds on the latter date and 34,665,000 pounds on the former date, a seasonal decline of 3 percent. From a year earlier, stocks of 442 firms that reported on both dates showed a gain of 38 percent. Pased on prevailing rates of sales, 461 firms estimated that their December 31, 1950 stocks represented 30 days surply, unchanged from September 30, but higher than the 21 days estimated a year earlier.

Stocks of canned condensed milk held by 50l firms on December 3l totaled 562,000 pounds. Stocks of 49l firms which reported for September 30 and December 3l registered a decline of 10 percent during the quarter, Compared with a year earlier, holdings of 442 firms that reported for both dates showed a gain of 46 percent.

On the reverse side of this report the stocks of wholesale grocers on December 31, 1950 are classified by size of cans and number of cans per case. According to this classification, 80 percent of all the evaporated milk stocks held on that date were in cases of  $48\ 14\frac{1}{2}$ -oz. cans.
