
PIG CROP REPORT

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FALL SOWS IN 10 STATES DOWN 3 PERCENT:

The number of sows farrowed and intended to farrow in the fall of 1960 (June through November) for 10 Corn Belt States is 3 percent smaller than in 1959, about the same as 1958, but 14 percent larger than the 1949-58 average, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The number is now estimated at 4,270,000 for the 10 States (Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas). Farrowings are below a year earlier in 7 States but above last year in South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas. Decreases are 8 percent in Ohio and Wisconsin, 6 percent in Indiana, 5 percent in Missouri, 2 percent in Illinois and Iowa, and I percent in Minnesota. The September I survey indicates a decrease of 10,000 sows from the farrowing intentions reported for these States as of June 1, 1960. The 10 States included in this report accounted for 73 percent of the United States 1959 total pig crop.

JUNE-AUGUST FARROWINGS DOWN 7 PERCENT:

Sows farrowed in the 10 States during June, July, and August totaled 2,232,000 head, 7 percent less than during the same period a year earlier. This was I percent less than was indicated for this period in June. June-August farrowings for these 10 States represent 52 percent of the estimated June-November total compared with the 10-year average of 51 percent. Farmers' reports indicate that the number of sows farrowed in June, July, and August were smaller than for the same months a year earlier, with the largest decline in June.

SEPTEMBER-NOVEMBER INTENDED FARROWINGS UP 3 PERCENT:

Sows bred and intended for farrowing in September, October, and November this year in the 10 States total 2,038,000 head, 3 percent more than a year earlier and 11 percent above average. This is 1 percent more than the farrowing intentions reported for these States in June.

DECEMBER-FEBRUARY INTENTIONS UP 4 PERCENT:

Reported breeding intentions indicate 1,789,000 sows to farrow during the 1961 winter quarter (December 1960 through February 1961) compared with 1,713,000 sows farrowed during the same period a year earlier, an increase of 4 percent. All States except Indiana and Nebraska indicate more sows will be

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farrowed during this quarter than farrowed a year earlier. Increases are South Dakota, 30 percent; Iowa, 7 percent; Ohio, Illinois, Minnesota, and Missouri, 5 percent; Wisconsin, 4 percent; and Kansas, 2 percent.

ALL HOGS AND PIGS DOWN 12 PERCENT:

The number of all hogs and pigs on farms September 1, 1960 in 10 States totaled 45,819,000 head. This is 12 percent less than the 52,008,000 head a year earlier. Decreases in hogs on farms this September compared to last year range from 8 percent in Ohio to 25 percent in South Dakota. Hogs and pigs 6 months old and over totaled 8,200,000 head, 17 percent less than last year. The number under 6 months of age was 11 percent less than last September. Hogs and pigs 3 to 6 months of age were 13 percent below those held a year earlier. Pigs under 3 months of age were 7 percent below last year, while sows farrowed June-August were also 7 percent below a year earlier. This indicates the litter size for June-August to be about the same as a year earlier. The 15,616,000 pigs under 3 months old on farms September 1 accounted for 34 percent of all hogs. Pigs 3-6 months of age totaled 22,003,000 head, or 48 percent of all hogs.
