

# PIG CROP REPORT

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The number of hogs and pigs of all ages on farms in the United States on December 1, 1963 totaled 61.3 million head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is a decrease of 4 percent from the 63.7 million head on farms a year earlier. Of the December 1, 1963 number, 85 percent or 52.1 million head were reported as other hogs and the remainder were being kept for breeding. The June-November 1963 pig crop of 42.8 million head was 4 percent less than the 1962 crop of 44.6 million head. The June-November 1963 crop combined with the December 1962-May 1963 crop makes a U. S. total pig crop of 93.0 million head, 1 percent less than the 1962 total pig crop. Reports based on farmers' intentions indicate that during the December 1963-May 1964 period 6.6 million sows will farrow, 6 percent less than the 7.0 million sows which farrowed in the same period a year earlier.

This report is based on a survey of farms and ranches. The data were obtained largely through the assistance of the Post Office Department and rural mail carriers.

HOGS ON FARMS DECEMBER 1, 1963: On December 1, 1963, there were 61,269,000 hogs and pigs of all ages on farms in the United States, down 4 percent from the 63,729,000 head on farms a year earlier. Inventory numbers on December 1 were less than a year earlier in 37 of the 50 States.

The inventory is divided into 2 groups: "hogs for breeding" and "other hogs". "Other hogs" are broken down by weight groups. Of this year's inventory on December 1, 15 percent of the total head were being kept for breeding, and 85 percent, or 52,065,000 head were "other hogs". The number and percentage of "other hogs" in each of the weight groups are as follows: Under 60 pounds, 18,597,000 head or 36 percent of the total "other"; 60-119 pounds, 13,730,000 head or 26 percent; 120-179 pounds, 10,909,000 head or 21 percent; 180-219 pounds, 6,522,000 head or 13 percent; and 220 pounds and over, 2,307,000 head or 4 percent.

In the 10 Corn Belt States -- Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas -- there were 46,804,000 hogs on farms, 3 percent less than a year earlier. Iowa, the leading hog-producing State, decreased 3 percent in the number on hand while Illinois decreased 1 percent, and Indiana 4 percent. The 10 Corn Belt States have 76 percent of the total United States inventory.

In these States on December 1 there were 7,107,000 head being held for breeding, and 39,697,000 head were "other hogs". Inventory numbers and percentages of "other hogs" in each weight group are as follows: Under 60 pounds, 13,648,000 head or 34 percent of the total "other hogs"; 60-119 pounds, 10,475,000 head or 26 percent; 120-179 pounds, 8,563,000 head or 22 percent; 180-219 pounds, 5,396,000 head or 14 percent; and 220 pounds and over, 1,615,000 head or 4 percent.

JUNE-NOVEMBER 1963 U. S. FIG CROP DOWN 4 PERCENT: The pig crop during the June-November 1963 period is estimated at 42,757,000 head. This is 4 percent less than the 1962 crop. All regions except the West showed declines from last year. The South Central States showed the greatest drop -- 8 percent. Decreases in other regions were: South Atlantic States, 7 percent; North Atlantic, 6 percent; East North Central and West North Central, each 3 percent. The Western Region was unchanged from a year ago.

Sows farrowing during June-November 1963 totaled 5,911,000 head, 4 percent less than a year earlier. June-November farrowings were 5 percentage points less than indicated by farmers' intentions reported last June. June-November 1963 farrowings and intentions reported last

June as percentages of 1962 by regions are as follows: North Atlantic, 92 and 101 percent; East North Central, 97 and 100 percent; West North Central, 97 and 103 percent; South Atlantic, 92 and 99 percent; South Central, 91 and 95 percent; Western, 101 and 101 percent.

Pigs saved per litter averaged 7.23 in the June-November 1963 period, equalling the record high of last year.

June sow farrowings were up 2 percent and July sow farrowings were up 3 percent more than a year earlier. All other months show declines from a year earlier as follows: August, 10 percent; September, 8 percent; October, 3 percent; and November, 6 percent.

JUNE-AUGUST FIG CROP IN 10 CORN BELT STATES: The June-August 1963 pig crop in the 10 States totaled 17,172,000 head. Sows farrowing in these States during June-August totaled 2,374,000 head. This is about the same as the number farrowing during the same period last year. Pigs per litter averaged 7.23 in the June-August 1963 period. No comparisons with earlier years for pig crop or pigs per litter are available.

SEPTEMBER-NOVEMBER FIG CROP IN 10 CORN BELT STATES: For the 10 States, the September-November 1963 pig crop totaled 15,567,000 head. A total of 2,143,000 sows farrowed during the September-November period, 6 percent below a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.26 in the September-November period.

DECEMBER 1962-MAY 1963 FIG CROP UP 1 PERCENT: The December 1962-May 1963 pig crop for the U. S. is estimated at 50,215,000 head, up 1 percent from a year earlier. A total of 7,027,000 sows farrowed during this period, practically unchanged from the 7,023,000 farrowed during the same period a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.15 compared with 7.08 in 1962.

The December-May pig crop in the 10 States totaled 39,418,000 head and was 2 percent larger than 38,509,000 head for the same period in 1962. There were 5,489,000 sows which farrowed with an average of 7.18 per litter.

ANNUAL FIG CROP DOWN 1 PERCENT: The total U. S. pig crop for the December 1962-November 1963 period was 92,972,000 head, 1 percent less than a year ago.

The annual 1963 pig crop in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 72,157,000 head, slightly less than a year earlier.

DECEMBER 1963-MAY 1964 INTENTIONS DOWN 6 PERCENT: Farmers' reports on breeding intentions for the December 1963-May 1964 period indicate 6,599,000 sows to farrow--6 percent less than a year earlier. If intentions for December-May farrowings materialize and number of pigs per litter equals the average with an allowance for trend, the 1964 spring pig crop would be 47.5 million head, 5 percent smaller than a year earlier.

The 10 Corn Belt States indicate 5 percent fewer farrowings December 1963-May 1964 than a year earlier. Intentions are to farrow 1,761,000 sows in the period December-February and 3,431,000 to farrow March-May--down 4 and 6 percent respectively. Decreases in expected December to May farrowings by regions are as follows: North Atlantic, down 6 percent; East North Central, down 6 percent; West North Central, down 5 percent; South Atlantic, off 7 percent; South Central, down 10 percent; and West, 9 percent less.
