

PIG CROP REPORT

JUNE 1964

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The December 1963-May 1964 pig crop totaled 46,479,000 head, 8 percent below the 50,340,000 head for the same period a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The number of sows farrowing during the period was 6,434,000 head, 9 percent less than the 7,045,000 farrowed a year earlier. The average number of pigs per litter was a record 7.22 compared with 7.15 for last year.

Based on breeding intentions reports, the June-November 1964 farrowings are expected to total 5,628,000 sows, 7 percent less than the 6,035,000 sows farrowed during the 1963 period. If these intentions materialize and the number of pigs per litter equals the average plus an allowance for trend, the June-November 1964 pig crop will total 40.5 million head, 7 percent less than the 1963 crop. This year's December 1963-November 1964 crop would then be 87.0 million head, 7 percent less than in 1963.

The number of hogs and pigs on farms in the 10 Corn Belt States on June 1, 1964 totaled 46,252,000 head, a decrease of 5 percent from the 48,832,000 head on farms a year earlier. This report is based on a survey of farms and ranches. The data were obtained largely through the assistance of the Post Office Department and rural mail carriers.

HOGS ON FARMS JUNE 1, 1964 - 10 CORN BELT STATES

On June 1, 1964, there were 46,252,000 hogs and pigs of all ages on farms in 10 Corn Belt States, 5 percent less than the 48,832,000 on farms a year earlier, and 5 percent less than the 48,496,000 on farms on June 1, 1962. These 10 States normally produce about three-fourths of the pigs in the United States.

Inventory numbers on June 1 were less than a year earlier in all 10 States. Iowa, the leading hog-producing State, decreased 3 percent in the numbers on hand. Ohio also showed a 3 percent decline. Indiana and Missouri were each down 4 percent; Illinois, down 5 percent; South Dakota, 6 percent; Minnesota, 8 percent; Nebraska, 10 percent; Kansas, 11 percent; and Wisconsin was down 13 percent.

June 1 inventories this year show a seasonal increase of 15 percent from the 40,070,000 head that were on farms on March 1, 1964. This increase may be compared with the increase of 17 percent for this period a year earlier and 18 percent in 1962.

The number of hogs and pigs on farms in the 10 States on June 1, 1964 being kept for breeding totaled 6,942,000 head. This is 8 percent less than the 7,574,000 head of breeding stock on farms a year earlier, reflecting the reduction in sows farrowing. Hogs and pigs other than those kept for breeding on farms on June 1, 1964 totaled 39,310,000 head, 5 percent less than the 41,258,000 head on farms a year earlier. Classified by weight groups, the number of other hogs and pigs and the percentage change from the previous year are: less than 60 pounds, 21,431,000 head, down 8 percent; 60-119 pounds, 8,641,000 head, down 5 percent; 120-179 pounds, 5,247,000 head, up 3 percent; 180-219 pounds, 2,938,000 head, up 2 percent; and 220 pounds and over, 1,053,000 head, up 4 percent.

The December 1, 1963 estimate of all hogs and pigs for the 10 States is not being published in this report. However, on the basis of data that has become available since the original report and with the upward revision of the June-November 1963 pig crop, it appears that it will be necessary to revise the December 1, 1963 inventory estimate upward about 1 percent. Revisions will be published at the usual time in the December 1, 1964 report.

DECEMBER 1963-MAY 1964 PIG CROP DOWN 8 PERCENT

The December 1963-May 1964 pig crop for the United States is estimated at 46,479,000 head. This is a decrease of 8 percent from the 50,340,000 pig crop during the corresponding period of a year earlier. Largest reductions in the December-May pig crop in comparison with a year earlier were in the North Atlantic and South Central regions with declines of 16 and 14 percent, respectively. Declines in other regions were 9 percent in the West, 8 percent in the South Atlantic, 7 percent in the West North Central, and 6 percent in the East North Central.

Sows farrowing during the December 1963-May 1964 period totaled 6,434,000 head, 9 percent less than the 7,045,000 sows farrowed during the same period a year earlier. December-May farrowings were 3 percentage points less than indicated by farmers' intentions reported on December 1, 1963. December-May farrowings and intentions reported last December as a percentage of a year earlier by regions are as follows: North Atlantic, 85 percent now and 94 percent in December; East North Central, 93 and 94; West North Central, 92 and 95; South Atlantic, 91 and 93; South Central, 85 and 90; and Western 90 and 91 percent.

The number of pigs per litter during the December-May period averaged 7.22 compared with 7.15 during the same period last year.

Farrowings were down from a year earlier in each month of the December-May period. December farrowings were down 5 percent, January 9 percent, February 12 percent, March 8 percent, April 11 percent, and May 4 percent.

The December 1963-February 1964 pig crop in the 10 States totaled 12,211,000 head, 5 percent less than the 12,825,000 head for this period a year earlier. Sows farrowing in these States during this period totaled 1,689,000 head, 8 percent less than the 1,836,000 farrowings for a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.23 compared with 6.99 for this period a year earlier.

The March-May 1964 pig crop in the 10 States totaled 24,524,000 head, 8 percent less than the 26,593,000 head for this period last year. Sow farrowings in these States during this period totaled 3,377,000 head, 8 percent less than the 3,653,000 farrowings for a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.26, compared with 7.28 for this period in 1963.

JUNE-NOVEMBER 1964 INTENTIONS DOWN 7 PERCENT

June 1 reports from farmers in the United States on breeding intentions indicate 5,628,000 sows will farrow during the June-November period of 1964, down 7 percent from the 6,035,000 sows farrowed during the corresponding period of 1963.

If intentions for the June-November farrowings materialize, and the number of pigs saved per litter equals the average plus an allowance for trend, the pig crop for the period will total 40.5 million head, 7 percent less than a year earlier. The combined pig crop for 1964 would be 87.0 million head, 7 percent less than the 1963 pig crop.

Decreases expected in June-November sow farrowings by regions are as follows: North Atlantic, 8 percent; East North Central, 8 percent; West North Central, 4 percent; South Atlantic, 6 percent; South Central, 14 percent; and West, 3 percent less.

Sows bred and intended for farrowing in 10 States in June, July, and August in 1964 totaled 2,274,000 head, 6 percent less than a year earlier. Decreases from a year earlier were indicated in 7 out of the 10 States, ranging from 2 percent in Iowa to 11 percent in Illinois. Nebraska showed no change and South Dakota and Kansas both showed a 4 percent increase from the previous year. Expected farrowings by months are: 778,000 sows indicated for June, compared with 777,000 farrowed during June a year earlier; 645,000 head indicated for July, down 9 percent; and 851,000 head for August 1964, a decrease of 8 percent from a year earlier.

Reported breeding intentions indicate 2,072,000 sows to farrow during the September-November 1964 quarter in the 10 States. This would be 6 percent less than a year earlier. All States except Kansas indicated decreases from a year earlier ranging from 14 percent in Wisconsin to 1 percent in Nebraska. Kansas indicated a 3 percent increase from a year earlier.
