There were 55.1 million hogs and pigs on farms in the United States on December 1, 1966, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This was 9 percent above the 50.5 million head a year earlier. Hogs kept for breeding purposes totaled 8.6 million, up 4 percent. The remainder, kept for other purposes, totaled 46.5 million, an increase of 10 percent. The June-November 1966 pig crop of 39.8 million head was 9 percent above the 36.4 million a year earlier. The combined December 1965-May 1966 and June-November 1966 crops totaled 85.5 million head, 8 percent more than the 1965 crop of 78.9 million head. Farmers intend to farrow 6.4 million sows during the December 1966-May 1967 period, 3 percent more sows than were farrowed during the comparable period a year earlier.

HOGS ON FARMS UP 9 PERCENT

The 55,114,000 hogs and pigs on U.S. farms on December 1, 1966, compare with 50,519,000 on December 1, 1965, an increase of 9 percent. Hogs and pigs being kept for breeding totaled 8,577,000 head, 4 percent more than the number on hand a year earlier. Hogs and pigs other than those kept for breeding totaled 46,537,000 head, up 10 percent. By weight groups, the number of other hogs and pigs on farms December 1, 1966, and the percentage change from the previous year are: less than 60 pounds, 16,763,000 head, up 9 percent; 60-119 pounds, 12,494,000 head, up 9 percent; 120-179 pounds, 9,567,000 head, up 10 percent; 180-219 pounds, 5,756,000 head, up 12 percent; and 220 pounds and heavier, 1,957,000 head, up 20 percent.

The number of hogs and pigs on farms December 1, 1966, in the 10 Corn Belt States -- Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas -- totaled 42,511,000 head, an increase of 8 percent from a year earlier. Iowa, with over one-fourth of the Nation's hogs and pigs on hand December 1, had an increase of 10 percent. Other leading States increased numbers as follows: Illinois, 7 percent; Indiana, 9 percent; Missouri, 10 percent; and Minnesota, 3 percent. The 10 Corn Belt States accounted for 77 percent of the Nation's total inventory of hogs and pigs.

JUNE-NOVEMBER PIG CROP UP 9 PERCENT

The Nation's pig crop during June-November 1966 is estimated at 39,755,000 head, up 9 percent from a year earlier. Each region showed increases. The South Central region had the largest gain, 17 percent. Increases in other regions were: North Atlantic, 10 percent; East North Central, 6 percent; West North Central, 9 percent; South Atlantic, 11 percent; and West, 15 percent.

Sows farrowing during June-November 1966 totaled 5,487,000 head, 10 percent more than a year earlier. This increase was the same as indicated by farmers' intentions reported last June. By regions, June-November farrowings compared with intentions reported last June, as percentage gains over a year earlier, are: North Atlantic, 8 percent now and 7 percent in June; East North Central 6 and 9; West North Central 10 and 7; South Atlantic 12 and 15; South Central 18 and 18; West 13 and 12.

Average litter size for farrowings during June-November 1966 was 7.25, slightly less than the record of 7.27 pigs per litter a year earlier. The number of sows farrowing was greater than a year earlier in each month of the period. The increases are as follow: June, 7 percent; July, 18 percent; August, 7 percent; September, 8 percent; October, 10 percent; and November, 7 percent.

JUNE-AUGUST PIG CROP UP 8 PERCENT

The 10 Corn Belt States produced 15,370,000 pigs during the June-August 1966 quarter, an increase of 8 percent from 1965. Farrowings totaled 2,136,000 during the period, 9 percent more than a year earlier. The average litter size for the quarter was 7.20 pigs.

SEPTEMBER-NOVEMBER PIG CROP UP 8 PERCENT

The September-November pig crop in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 15,026,000 pigs, 8 percent more than during the same period in 1965. The number of sows farrowing in these States during the period totaled 2,061,000 head and averaged 7.29 pigs per litter.

DECEMBER 1965-MAY 1966 PIG CROP UP 8 PERCENT

The December 1965-May 1966 pig crop nationally was 45,771,000 head, up 8 percent from a year earlier. There were 6,249,000 sows farrowed during these months, up 6 percent from the previous year. Average litter size was 7.32 pigs.

The December-May pig crop for the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 36,118,000 head, 7 percent more than a year earlier. This pig crop was farrowed by 4,912,000 sows with an average litter size of 7.35 pigs.

ANNUAL U.S. PIG CROP UP 8 PERCENT

The total pig crop for the December 1965-November 1966 period in the U.S. was 85,526,000 head, 8 percent more than a year earlier. The 10 Corn Belt States' annual pig crop was 66,514,000 head, up 7 percent.

FARROWING INTENTIONS FOR DECEMBER 1966-MAY 1967 UP 3 PERCENT

U.S. hog farmers reported intentions to farrow 6,420,000 sows during the December 1966-May 1967 period, 3 percent more than a year earlier but 7 percent less than average. Increases from last year in the number of sows farrowing are indicated in all regions, as follows: South Central, up 10 percent; South Atlantic, 7 percent; West, 3 percent; North Atlantic region, 3 percent; East North Central, 2 percent; and West North Central, up 1 percent.

If these intentions are realized, the December-May 1967 pig crop would approximate 47.2 million head, or 3 percent above a year earlier.

Sows bred and intended for farrowing in the 10 Corn Belt States during December 1966-February 1967 total 1,699,000 head, 6 percent more than a year earlier. All States except South Dakota show increases. Expected farrowings by months in these 10 States are: December 426,000 sows, up 9 percent; January, 543,000 sows, up 3 percent; and February, 730,000 sows, up 5 percent.

Reported breeding intentions indicate 3,293,000 sows to farrow in the March-May quarter in the 10 States. This is about the same as the 1966 March-May number farrowed.

REVISION IN ESTIMATES

The estimates of the number of hogs on farms, sows farrowing and pig crops have been revised on the basis of data obtained from the Census of Agriculture taken in the fall of 1964 and other data which have become available since the original estimates were made. Revised estimates by States for the years 1960-64 were shown in Statistical Bulletin No. 383, "Hog Inventory and Pig Crops", U.S. Department of Agriculture, Statistical Reporting Service. This bulletin is available on request.

The revisions for December 1 numbers on farms resulted in a downward revision of 3 percent in 1964. For sows farrowing, the revision in 1964 amounted to less than 1 percent for December-May sows and 2 percent for June-November sows. These percentages represent errors accumulated since the 1959 Census of Agriculture. A further revision of 3 percent was made in the December 1, 1965 inventory and 2 percent in the June-November pig crop. These would have been required regardless of the revisions made in the review of the 1964 Census enumeration. Marketings for slaughter during December 1965 and the first part of 1966 did not reflect the changes that were indicated by the June-November 1965 pig crop and the December 1, 1965 inventory. Current estimates are based on mailed and enumerated samples. It now appears that the mail samples did not fully reflect those farmers who went out of hog production. New techniques using more enumeration are now providing additional data which should more nearly reflect the changes in hog production particularly at the regional and national level.
