MARCH 1967

The number of hogs and pigs on farms in the 10 Corn Belt States on March 1, 1967 totaled 37.5 million head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is an increase of 3 percent from the year-earlier total of 36.3 million head. Included here is information for the 10 States: Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas.

Inventory numbers on March 1 were above a year earlier in nine of the 10 States. Indiana had a 2-percent decrease, but Kansas was up 13 percent; Missouri, 10 percent; Nebraska, 6 percent; Wisconsin, Iowa and South Dakota, each, 3 percent; Ohio and Illinois, each 2 percent; and Minnesota, 1 percent.

The March 1 inventory decreased 13 percent from the revised level of 43.1 million head on hand December 1, 1966. This seasonal decrease is compared with 8 percent for this period a year earlier and the average of 14 percent.

Of the total March 1 inventory, 7,024,000 head were being kept for breeding, 4 percent less than a year earlier. Hogs and pigs, other than for breeding, totaled 30,466,000 head, 5 percent more than the 29,034,000 on hand March 1, 1966.

A weight breakdown of the other hogs and pigs (intended mostly for marketing) when compared with a year earlier shows: The under 60 pound group at 11,312,000 head, up 4 percent; the 60-119 pound group, 6,474,000 head, up 5 percent; 120-179 pounds, 7,407,000 head, up 3 percent; 180-219 pounds, 4,348,000 head, up 9 percent; and the 220 pounds and over group, 925,000 head, up 10 percent.

DECEMBER-FEBRUARY PIG CROP

The December-February 1967 pig crop for the 10 States totaled 12,426,000 head, an increase of 5 percent from the same period a year earlier. The number of sows farrowed was 1,698,000 head, 6 percent more than the 1,609,000 for the December-February 1966 period. The average number of pigs per litter for the December-February 1967 period, at 7.32, is down slightly from a year earlier. On December 1, 1966 farmers in the 10 States reported plans to increase farrowings by 6 percent during the December 1966-February 1967 period.

OFFICIAL BUSINESS

For December 1966, the 438,000 sows farrowed were 12 percent above a year earlier. January 1967 farrowings, at 539,000 were 3 percent above January 1966, and for February, at 721,000, were 4 percent above a year earlier.

MARCH-MAY INTENTIONS

Sows bred and intended for farrowing during the March-May quarter totaled 3,208,000 head, 3 percent less than a year earlier. Wisconsin and Kansas each show increases, Missouri and Nebraska show no change from a year earlier, but all other States expect decreases. Expected monthly farrowings are: March, 1,139,000 sows, down 2 percent from a year earlier; April, 1,237,000, down 4 percent, and May, 832,000, down 2 percent. Intentions for the March-May quarter reported on March 1, 1967 are 3 percentage points or 85,000 head less than the intentions reported for this period on December 1, 1966.

JUNE-AUGUST INTENTIONS

Breeding intentions are for 2,066,000 sows to farrow during the June-August 1967 quarter, 5 percent below a year earlier. Missouri and Kansas show increases of 5 and 3 percent, respectively. Declines range from 2 percent in Iowa to 13 percent in Minnesota.

NOTE: Revised estimates of the December 1, 1966 hog and pig inventory and the June-November 1966 pig crop for the 10 States in the quarterly program are shown in this report.
