

PIG CROP REPORT

JUNE 1967

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The December 1966-May 1967 pig crop totaled 46.0 million head, up 1 percent from the 45.6 million head for the same period a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. A total of 6.3 million sows farrowed in the December-May period, 1 percent more than the 6.2 million for the corresponding period a year earlier. The number of pigs per litter averaged 7.34 compared with 7.32 last year.

Hog producers indicated on June 1 they intended to farrow 5.5 million sows during June-November 1967, 3 percent less than the 5.6 million sows farrowed during the same period last year. If these intentions are carried out and if the number of pigs per litter equals the average adjusted for an allowance for trend, the June-November 1967 pig crop will total 39.6 million head, 3 percent below last year. The 1967 annual pig crop (December 1966 through November 1967) would be 85.5 million head, 1 percent less than in 1966.

The June 1, 1967 inventory of all hogs and pigs on farms in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 43.6 million head, 1 percent less than the 44.3 million head on hand June 1, 1966.

HOGS ON FARMS JUNE 1, 1967 - 10 CORN BELT STATES

Hogs and pigs of all ages on farms June 1, 1967 in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 43,642,000 head, down 1 percent from a year earlier, but 4 percent more than the June 1, 1965 inventory. These 10 States normally produce three-fourths of the United States pig crop. In Iowa, the leading hog producing State, numbers were down 1 percent from a year earlier. Decreases in other States were: Ohio, 8 percent; Indiana, 11 percent; Wisconsin, 2 percent; and South Dakota, 6 percent. Increases in inventories were Kansas, 7 percent; Missouri, 5 percent; and Nebraska, 2 percent. Numbers were unchanged in Illinois and Minnesota. June 1 inventories this year were up 16 percent from March 1, compared with an increase of 22 percent during this period in 1966.

The number of hogs and pigs on farms June 1, being kept for breeding in the 10 States totaled 6,462,000 head, down 5 percent from a year earlier. Hogs and pigs other than those kept for breeding totaled 37,180,000 head, 1 percent less than the 37,498,000 head on farms June 1, last year. By weight groups, the number of other hog and pig numbers on farms June 1, 1967 and the percentage changes from a year earlier were: under 60 pounds, 19,403,000 head, down 5 percent; 60-119 pounds, 8,733,000 head, up 4 percent; 120-179 pounds, 5,183,000 head, up 1 percent; 180-219 pounds, 2,901,000 head, up 9 percent; 220 pounds and over 960,000 head, up 9 percent.

DECEMBER 1966-MAY 1967 PIG CROP UP 1 PERCENT

The U. S. pig crop for December 1966 - May 1967 totaled 45,949,000 head, 1 percent more than in the same period a year earlier. Each region showed an increase except the East North Central which was down 3 percent. Increases were: North Atlantic, 4 percent; West North Central, 1 percent; South Atlantic, 7 percent; South Central, 6 percent, and the West, 5 percent.

The December-May farrowings were 2 percentage points less than indicated by farmers' intentions last December. By regions, December-May farrowings compared with intentions reported last December as percent of a year earlier are: North Atlantic, 101 percent

now and 103 percent in December; East North Central, 97 and 102; West North Central, 101 and 101; South Atlantic, 107 and 107; South Central, 104 and 110; and West, 106 and 103.

The average number of pigs per litter was a record high of 7.34 for December-May compared with 7.32 a year earlier. The number of sows farrowing during each month of the December-May period ranged from 96 percent of the same month a year earlier in April to 111 percent in December. March farrowings were 99 percent of a year earlier, May was unchanged, and January and February were 103 and 104, respectively, of a year earlier.

The December 1966-February 1967 pig crop in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 12,425,000 head, 5 percent more than the December-February 1966 crop of 11,836,000 head. Sows farrowing in the 10 States during the period totaled 1,698,000 head, 5 percent more than the 1,611,000 in the comparable period a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.32 compared with 7.35 a year earlier.

The March-May 1967 pig crop in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 23,400,000, 3 percent less than the 24,106,000 head for the comparable 1966 period. Sows farrowing in the 10 States during this period totaled 3,175,000 head, 3 percent less than the 3,277,000 head a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.37 compared with 7.36 a year earlier.

JUNE-NOVEMBER INTENTIONS

June 1 reports from farmers on breeding intentions indicate that 5,452,000 sows will farrow in the United States during June-November 1967. This is a 3-percent decrease from the 5,648,000 sows farrowing during the corresponding period of 1966 and is 4 percent below average. Decreases from 1966 by regions are as follows: North Atlantic, 3 percent; East North Central,

8 percent; West North Central, 2 percent; and West, 1 percent. The South Atlantic region was the same as a year earlier and the South Central region showed a 2-percent increase.

If intentions for June-November farrowings materialize and the number of pigs per litter equals the average plus an allowance for trend, the pig crop for the period will total 39,600,000, a decrease 3 percent from a year earlier. The combined 1967 pig crop at 85,549,000, would be 1 percent below the 1966 pig crop.

Sows bred and intended for farrowing in 10 Corn Belt States during June, July, and August in 1967 totaled 2,100,000 head, 5 percent less than a year earlier. Missouri and Kansas were the only States showing an increase in intended farrowings. Nebraska and South Dakota were the same as a year earlier and the remaining 6 States showed decreases ranging from 2 percent in Iowa to 13 percent in Indiana. Expected farrowings by months in the 10 States are: June 702,000 sows, down 6 percent from June 1966; July 648,000 sows, down 6 percent; and August, 750,000 sows, down 3 percent.

Reported breeding intentions indicate 2,025,000 sows to farrow during the September-November quarter in the 10 States. This would be 4 percent less than the number farrowed in the same period a year earlier. South Dakota and Nebraska were the only two States showing increases in farrowing from September-November 1966.
