SEPTEMBER 1967

The number of hogs and pigs on farms in the 10 Corn Belt States on September 1, 1967 is estimated at 45,500,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is a decrease of 1 percent from the 46,114,000 head a year earlier, but 3,571,000 head or 9 percent above the 41,929,000 head on September 1, 1965. The 10 States included in this report are Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas. Estimates for certain items for previous quarters have been revised and are in the table on page 2.

Inventory numbers on September 1, 1967 were larger than a year earlier in Kansas -- 4 percent, Missouri -- 3 percent, and South Dakota -- 2 percent, but smaller in each of the other States except Iowa which was unchanged. Illinois, Minnesota, and Nebraska were down 2 percent, Ohio was down 3 percent, Wisconsin 5 percent, and Indiana 8 percent. The September 1 inventory for the 10 States increased about 2 percent from June 1, about the same as the usual June 1 to September 1 increase.

Hogs and pigs kept for breeding September 1 this year, totaled 6,241,000 head -- about the same as the number kept for breeding on farms a year earlier. Other hogs and pigs declined from 39,863,000 on September 1, 1966 to 39,259,000 on September 1, 1967. Compared with a year earlier other hogs and pigs in the under 60 pound weight group increased 1 percent to 13,668,000 head and the 180-219 pound group increased 3 percent to 5,076,000. Other hogs and pigs in the 60-119 pound group declined 6 percent from a year earlier to 10,228,000, the 120-179 pound group declined 1 percent to 9,360,000 and the 220 pound and over group declined 1 percent to 927,000.

JUNE-AUGUST PIG CROP

The June-August 1967 pig crop in the 10 States is estimated at 16,217,000 head, 1 percent below the June-August 1966 pig crop of 16,327,000 head. Sows farrowed during June-August 1967 totaled 2,198,000 head -- a decrease of 3 percent from the year earlier period. The average number of pigs per litter increased to 7.38 pigs from 7.20 a year earlier. On June 1, 1967 farmers in the 10 States reported intentions to decrease sow farrowings 5 percent during June-August from the same months in 1966. The number of sows farrowed during June 1967 was 766,000 head, 1 percent less than the number farrowed in June a year earlier. July farrowings, at 653,000 head, were 8 percent less than July 1966 and August farrowings, at 779,000, were 2 percent below August 1966.

SEPTEMBER-NOVEMBER INTENTIONS

Sows bred for farrowing in the 10 States during September, October, and November totaled 2,132,000 head, 1 percent less than a year earlier. Only two States, Nebraska and South Dakota, indicated an increase in farrowing intentions compared with a year earlier. Iowa and Illinois expect to farrow the same number as last year. Decreases in the other 6 States ranged from 1 percent in Kansas to 10 percent in Ohio. Expected farrowings by months are: September - 1,062,000 sows, 6 percent less than the number farrowed a year ago; October - 675,000 sows, up 1 percent, and November - 395,000 sows, up 10 percent. The September 1 intentions for September-November farrowings are 5 percentage points above the intentions reported for this period on June 1, 1967.

DECEMBER 1967 - FEBRUARY 1968 INTENTIONS

Breeding intentions are for 1,703,000 sows to farrow during the December 1967-February 1968 quarter, 2 percent less than the same quarter a year earlier. Three States, Minnesota, Missouri, and South Dakota expect increases. Iowa expects no change from a year earlier. Other States show decreases ranging from 2 percent in Indiana to 10 percent in Kansas.
