

# PIG CROP REPORT

DECEMBER 1967

There were 57.9 million hogs and pigs on farms in the United States on December 1, 1967, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This was 1 percent above the 57.1 million head a year earlier. Hogs kept for breeding purposes totaled 9.0 million, up 2 percent. The remainder, kept for other purposes, totaled 48.9 million, an increase of 1 percent. The June-November 1967 pig crop of 43.0 million head was 2 percent above the 42.1 million a year earlier. The combined December 1966-May 1967 and June-November 1967 crops totaled 91.3 million head, 4 percent more than the 1966 crop of 87.6 million head. Farmers reported intentions to farrow 6.5 million sows during the December 1967-May 1968 period, 1 percent less than were farrowed in the same period a year earlier.

### HOGS ON FARMS UP 1 PERCENT

Hogs on U. S. farms on December 1, 1967 were estimated at 57,943,000 head compared with 57,126,000 on December 1, 1966, an increase of 1 percent. Hogs and pigs kept for breeding totaled 9,039,000 head, 2 percent more than the number a year earlier. Hogs and pigs other than those kept for breeding totaled 48,904,000 head, up 1 percent. By weight groups, the number of other hogs and pigs on farms December 1, 1967, and the percentage change from the previous year are: less than 60 pounds, 17,770,000 head, increased 3 percent; 60-119 pounds, 13,210,000 head also up 3 percent; 120-179 pounds, 9,709,000 head, declined 2 percent; 180-219 pounds, 6,142,000 head, gained 1 percent; and 220 pounds and heavier, 2,073,000 head, increased slightly.

The number of hogs and pigs on farms December 1, 1967 in the 10 Corn Belt States -- Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas -- totaled 44,180,000 head, compared with 44,055,000 a year earlier, an increase of less than 1 percent. Breeding hogs, at 6,914,000 head, were up 2 percent. Other hogs totaled 37,266,000 head, and were virtually the same as a year earlier. Iowa, with over one-fourth of the Nation's hogs and pigs on December 1, had an increase in total inventory of 1 percent. Other leading States showing increase were Missouri, up 8 percent, South Dakota, up 6 percent, and Kansas up 5 percent. These gains were mainly offset by declines of 1 percent in Minnesota and Nebraska, 2 percent in Ohio and Illinois, 4 percent in Indiana, and 5 percent in Wisconsin. The 10 Corn Belt States accounted for 76 percent of the Nation's total inventory of hogs and pigs.

### JUNE-NOVEMBER PIG CROP UP 2 PERCENT

The June-November 1967 pig crop is estimated at 42,950,000 head, 2 percent more than a year earlier. The South Central States led with a 6-percent increase. The West North Central and South Atlantic States were up 3 percent, while the East North Central States were unchanged and the Western States were down 4 percent and the North Atlantic States down 7 percent.

The 5,820,000 sows farrowed during June-November 1967 was about the same as the 5,811,000 sows a year earlier. Regionally, June-November 1967 sows farrowed were down 7 percent in North Atlantic, and 3 percent in East North Central and West, but up 4 percent in South Central and 1 percent in West North Central and South Atlantic.

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Average litter size during June-November 1967 was at a record high 7.38 pigs per litter. Average litter size was 7.25 pigs a year earlier and the previous record was 7.27 pigs per litter during June-November 1965.

#### JUNE-AUGUST PIG CROP STEADY

The 10 Corn Belt States produced 16,530,000 pigs during June-August 1967, slightly more than the 16,476,000 head a year earlier. Farrowings totaled 2,240,000 during the quarter, down 2 percent from 1966. Average litter size was 7.38 pigs for the quarter, compared with 7.19 pigs a year earlier.

#### SEPTEMBER-NOVEMBER PIG CROP UP 3 PERCENT

The September-November pig crop, at 16,247,000 head in the 10 Corn Belt States, was up 3 percent from a year earlier. A total of 2,194,000 sows were farrowed during the period, with an average litter size of 7.41 pigs, compared with 2,154,000 sows and a litter size of 7.31 pigs in 1966.

#### DECEMBER 1966-MAY 1967 PIG CROP UP 6 PERCENT

The national pig crop totaled 48,360,000 head during December 1966-May 1967. This was up 6 percent from a year earlier. Farrowings reached 6,591,000 during the period, up from the 6,201,000 sows a year earlier. Litters averaged 7.34 pigs. The 10 Corn Belt States accounted for 37,469,000 head or 77 percent from 5,096,000 farrowings, having an average litter of 7.35 pigs.

#### ANNUAL U. S. PIG CROP UP 4 PERCENT

The total U. S. pig crop for the December 1966-November 1967 period was 91,310,000 head, a gain of 4 percent from a year earlier. The annual pig crop in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 70,246,000 head, up 3 percent from 1966.

#### FARROWING INTENTIONS FOR DECEMBER 1967-MAY 1968 DOWN 1 PERCENT

U. S. hog producers reported intentions to farrow 6,522,000 sows during the December 1967-May 1968 period, 1 percent less than a year earlier and 3 percent below average. Except in the South Central declines from a year earlier in numbers of sows to farrow are indicated. South Central producers expect to farrow 7 percent more sows. Regional declines expected are: South Atlantic, 1 percent; West 2 percent; North Atlantic, 3 percent; East North Central, 3 percent; and West North Central, 2 percent.

If these intentions are realized and the number of pigs saved per litter follows the trend of recent years, the December-May 1968 pig crop would approximate 47.9 million head, 1 percent less than a year earlier.

Farrowing intentions in the 10 Corn Belt States during December 1967-February 1968 indicates 1,749,000 head, about the same as a year earlier. Decreases in Ohio, Illinois, and Nebraska were offset by increases in five other States. No change is expected in Iowa and Wisconsin. Expected farrowings by months in these 10 States are: December, 447,000 sows, up 1 percent; January, 573,000, up 3 percent; and February, 729,000 down 2 percent.

Reported breeding intentions indicate 3,248,000 sows to farrow in March-May 1968 in the 10 Corn Belt States, a decline of 3 percent from a year earlier. Small increases in Indiana, Wisconsin and Kansas were more than offset by declines in six other States. No change from a year earlier is indicated in Iowa.
