Status

Appropriates funds for research on prevention and mitigation of Rapid

Ohia Death.

HB 1578

RELATING TO CLIMATE CHANGE.

EEP/AGR, FIN

Status

Establishes the carbon farming task force to identify agricultural

practices to improve soil health and promote carbon sequestration in

the State's agricultural and aquacultural sectors. Appropriates funds.

HB 788

RELATING TO SOLAR ENERGY FACILITIES.

EEP/AGR, FIN

Status Requires that solar energy facilities in residential housing areas in agricultural districts must meet certain conditions.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least <u>24 hours</u> prior to the hearing. Testimony should indicate:

- The Committee(s) to which the comments are directed;

- Measure number.
