Proposes a constitutional amendment to allow individuals who are seventeen years of age but will be eighteen years of age on or before the next state or local general election to vote at the state or local primary election immediately preceding the state or local general election by which the citizen will attain the age of eighteen.

Creates a separate offense for criminal property damage by

graffiti.

<u>SB 797</u>

Status & Testimony RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY RIGHTS.

Creates the offense of criminal property damage to a public restroom if a person intentionally or knowingly damages a toilet, urinal, bathroom stall, mirror, or sink so as to render it unusable, or sets fire to a trash receptacle. Defines public restroom.
