WAM Update statute relating to electronic funds transfers to allow Status & Automated Clearing House account debit transactions in certain **Testimony** situations as may be approved by the Director of Finance. **SB 1003** RELATING TO ELECTRONIC FILING. WAM Authorizes the Department of Taxation to require electronic filing Status & of tax returns, subject to exceptions for reasonable cause as **Testimony** provided by administrative rules. WAM Changes the frequency of filing returns of taxes withheld on Status & wages paid from monthly to quarterly for all employers. **Testimony** RELATING TO TAXATION. WAM **SB 648** Expands the low income-household renters' income tax credit Status & based on adjusted gross income and filing status. Establishes a **Testimony** state earned income tax credit. Restores the income tax rates for high income brackets that were repealed on 12/31/15.

Removes the sunset for the refundable food/excise tax credit.
