- 1 To amend Code Section 16-13-32.6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

- 3 substances or marijuana in, on, or within drug-free commercial zones, so as to change the
- 4 date of incorporation of local ordinances by reference; to repeal conflicting laws; and for

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 16-13-32.6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 manufacturing, distributing, dispensing, or possessing with intent to distribute controlled
- 10 substances or marijuana in, on, or within drug-free commercial zones, is amended by revising
- 11 subsection (f) as follows:
- 12 "(f) The General Assembly hereby adopts and incorporates into this Code section all
- drug-free commercial zones which have been adopted by municipal or county ordinance
- and entered in the register of the Department of Community Affairs as provided for in
- subsection (d) of this Code section on or before July 1, 2013 <u>2015</u>."

SECTION 2.
