# REGARDING PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 19, DIVISION 1, CHAPTER 5.5 AUTOMATIC FIRE EXTINGUISHING SYSTEMS CERTIFICATION

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN that the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) has proposed modifications to text of regulations to the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 19, Division 1, Chapter 5.5, Automatic Fire Extinguishing Systems Certification which were the subject of written comments from the initial 45 day Public Comment Period that began on February 12, 2016 thru March 28, 2016, and a Public Hearing conducted on April 7, 2016.

The 15-Day public comment period begins on July 27, 2016 to August 11, 2016. Comments on the additional modified text **must be submitted to the OSFM no later than 5:00pm on August 11, 2016.** 

The OSFM is proposing additional modifications to the proposed language to California Code of Regulations, Title 19, Automatic Fire Extinguishing Systems Certification.

The Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) received over three hundred public comments on the text as originally noticed. Upon review and consideration of the comments received, the OSFM determined that modifications to the text were deemed necessary to better clarify the reference documents for the proposed language, make other modifications and correct typographical errors to the text and forms. The most significant change was to the definition for JREP. This was changed to the Job Related Training and Experience Review (JRTER), which better describes its purpose. It is a means of validating time and experience and is not intended to be a "training program".
