NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION OF THE OFFICE OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL

AVAILABILITY OF MODIFIED TEXT SECOND 15-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

REGARDING PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 19, DIVISION 1, CHAPTER 5.5 AUTOMATIC FIRE EXTINGUISHING SYSTEMS CERTIFICATION

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN that the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) has proposed modifications to the text of regulations to the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 19, Division 1, Chapter 5.5, Automatic Fire Extinguishing Systems Certification which were the subject of written comments from the initial 45 day Public Comment Period that began on February 12, 2016 thru March 28, 2016, a Public Hearing conducted on April 7, 2016, and a 15 day public comment period on July 27, 2016 through August 11, 2016.

The "Second" 15-Day public comment period begins on December 21, 2016 to January 5, 2017. Comments on the additional modified text **must be submitted to the OSFM no later than** 5:00pm on January 5, 2017.

The OSFM is proposing additional modifications to the proposed language to California Code of Regulations, Title 19, Chapter 5.5, Automatic Fire Extinguishing Systems Certification.

Upon review and consideration of the comments received, the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) determined that modifications to the text were deemed necessary to better clarify the reference documents for the proposed language, make other modifications and correct typographical errors to the text and forms. The most significant change was for the elimination of the definition for JREP and associated JREP text and forms. Validation of time and experience will be through a state or federally approved apprenticeship program or through a C-16 employer as delineated in regulations.
