## Governor's MERIT Scholarship

Awarded to one qualified student from each Montana high school accredited by the Montana Board of Public Education. Students who continue to meet the requirements; \$2,000 per year, up to 4 years (contingent upon funding\*\*)

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Must be a 2017 graduate from a high school accredited by the Montana Board of Public Education
- Must be a resident of the State of Montana (Board of Regents Policy 940.1)
- Must be accepted by an eligible Montana campus (listed below)
- Must take the ACT/SAT by December 31st of the student's senior year
- Must obtain a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0 (calculated as of 7th semester) OR a score of at least 20 on the ACT OR 1050 on the SAT (1440 for tests prior to March 2016) college admissions tests
- Must begin using the next chronological semester (excluding summer)
- If a male, must meet the Title IV selective service requirements
- · Must not be incarcerated
- Must be seeking a first certificate, or 2-year or 4-year degree
- \*May not utilize a MUS Honor Scholarship for the same period of enrollment
- \*Applications scored utilizing the methodology in regents policy 501.1(I)(B).

#### **Renewing Governor's Scholarships**

- Must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (as defined by the campus)
- Must complete a minimum of 24 credits per academic year
- Renewals are contingent upon continued funding for this program\*\*

Awarded to students from Montana high schools accredited by the Montana Board of Public Education. Students who continue to meet the requirements; \$1,000 the first year and \$2,000 the second year (contingent upon funding\*\*)

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Must be a 2017 graduate from a high school accredited by the Montana Board of Public Education
- Must be a resident of the State of Montana (Board of Regents Policy 940.1)
- Must be accepted by an eligible Montana campus (listed below)
- Must obtain a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.25 (calculated as of 7th semester)
- Must complete 4 years of college prep math and 3 years of college prep science while in high school (verified by high school counselor)
- Must declare a STEM or Healthcare major (the list may be found by visiting www.mus.edu/scholarships)
- Must begin using the next chronological semester (excluding summer)
- Must enroll in and complete a minimum of 15 credits each semester
- If a male, must meet the Title IV selective service requirements
- · Must not be incarcerated
- Must be seeking a first certificate, or 2-year or 4-year degree

#### **Renewing STEM Scholarships**

- Must maintain 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Must enroll in and complete a minimum of 15 credits per semester
- Must continue to pursue a qualifying STEM or Healthcare major
- Renewals are contingent upon continued funding for this program\*\*

## \*\*IMPORTANT NOTE

Funding for the Governor's MERIT and STEM Scholarship Programs is not guaranteed and final approval for scholarship awards may be determined after the application period has ended. Criteria noted for each scholarship is used as a minimum starting point for consideration. Since the final number of scholarships may be limited, meeting the eligibility criteria does not guarantee selection.

Applying is a multi-step process. Students must complete each of the following steps by the deadline for their application to be considered;

- 1. Take the ACT or SAT by December 31st of your senior year (only required if applying for Governor's MERIT)
- 2. Apply to and be accepted by one of the eligible campuses
- 3. Register online at www.mus.edu/scholarships
- 4. Print application and have counselor sign Page 3 (only required if applying for STEM)
- 5. Mail the application and additional required documents
