Illinois Department of Insurance Disciplinary Report for October-December 2016

SPRINGFIELD – January 19, 2017. The Illinois Department of Insurance today announced the following disciplinary actions:

Suspensions:

Xavier Gaters, Dolton – Insurance producer license suspended effective October 6, 2016. Mr. Gaters had been licensed to sell life insurance since 2015. The suspension was based on a certification from the Department of Revenue and that Mr. Gaters has failed to pay state income tax, penalties, and interest and file a return due to the Department of Revenue.

Denials:
