Property Description

This 17th century wash house, built on a steep hill on the outskirts of Mdina, was built by the Knights for the perusal of the locals of Rabat and Mdina. Its façade is characterized by three stout semicircular arches, on top of which runs a plain band of masonry, which is repeated at roof level as a cornice. Three coat-of-arms, now defaced, are all centrally positioned each above every arch. The wash house has a flow of natural spring water, and a drainage system. However, it seems that the outflow drain is blocked, and thus, this is causing the spring water to seep into the ground and weakening the foundations. Consequently, a series of fissures are occurring all over the building as can be clearly seen on the façade. The interior of the wash house is characterized by a series of vaulted-arches, with a number of troughs were with the water flows for the washing of garments.
