SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2016 Report on MCC's Progress in Implementing Travel and Purchase Card Recommendations

Dear Mr. Donovan:

As required by the Government Charge Card Abuse Prevention Act of 2012 (Public Law 112-194) and in accordance with the Office of Management and Budget's guidance (OMB Memorandum M-13-21, "Implementation of the Government Charge Card Abuse Prevention Act of 2012"), we submit this annual report on the Millennium Challenge Corporation's (MCC) implementation of recommendations related to travel and purchase cards. Recommendations to consider include those that remain open and those closed during the past fiscal year.

On December 9, 2016, we transmitted a risk assessment of MCC's FY 2015 charge card programs (<u>M-000-17-002-C</u>). It found that the risk of illegal, improper, or erroneous purchases and payments in MCC's charge card programs was low and made no recommendations. A search of Office of Inspector General (OIG) recommendations found no open or closed recommendations related to purchase cards in fiscal year 2016.
