## sheep and lambs on feed



Seven Selected States
November 1, 1975

Sheep and lambs on feed in seven major feeding States on November 1, 1975 are estimated at 1,115,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is a decline of 13 percent from a year ago and 20 percent below November 1, 1973. Six States had declines -- varying from 36 percent in South Dakota to 12 percent in Texas. California increased by 12 percent from a year ago. Of the seven-State total on feed November 1, an estimated 177,000 were placed before September 1 and the remaining 938,000 were placed during September and October.

The number on feed by weight groups and the changes from a year earlier are as follows: Under 70 pounds -- 107,000 head, down 46,000; 70-79 pounds -- 258,000 head, down 68,000; 80=89 pounds -- 346,000 head, down 30,000; 90-99 pounds -- 258,000 head, down 57,000; 100 pounds and over -- 146,000 head, up 31,000.
