SHEEP AND LAMBS ON FEED DOWN 14 PERCENT

There were 611,000 sheep and lambs on feed in the 7 feeding States surveyed on March 1, 1976, a reduction of 14 percent from the number being readied for slaughter market a year earlier and 32 percent under the March 1, 1974 mark. The March 1, 1976 total was the lowest since the series started in 1960.

The number of sheep and lambs placed on feed during January and February, at 364,000 head, dropped 3 percent from the same period a year earlier while the January - February marketings declined 2 percent to 787,000 head.

EARLY LAMB CROP - 1976

The early lamb crop in California, Kansas and Texas totaled 1,489,000 head, down 4 percent from a year ago. The January 1 inventory of ewes one year old and older for these States was down 3 percent from a year earlier.
