Seven Selected States March 1, 1980

SHEEP AND LAMBS ON FEED DOWN 1 PERCENT FROM 1979

The number of sheep and lambs on feed in seven selected States on March 1, 1980 totaled 597 thousand head, down 1 percent from the 604 thousand head on feed a year ago. There were 287 thousand placed on feed during January and February this year, down 6 percent from the 306 thousand placed during the same period of 1979.

Of the total number on feed March 1, 1980, in the seven States:

9 percent weighed less than 70 pounds,

7 percent weighed 70-79 pounds,

14 percent weighed 80-89 pounds,

26 percent weighed 90-99 pounds,

44 percent weighed 100 pounds and over.

EARLY LAMB CROP UP 1 PERCENT

The early lamb crop in California, Kansas and Texas totaled 1.44 million head, up 1 percent from a year ago. The January 1 inventory of ewes one year old and older for these States was up less than 1 percent.
