Provider Notice 12-104

Effective for dates of service on and after January 1, 2013, the Medicaid Program of the Health Care Authority (the Agency) updated the <u>Home Health (Acute Care Services) Medicaid Provider Guide</u> with the following changes:

- Clarified that the benefit limits for outpatient rehabilitation which apply to clients 21 years of age and older *also* apply to clients 19 through 20 years of age in Medical Care Services (MCS) or Alcohol and Drug Addiction Treatment and Support Act (ADATSA).
- Clarified that therapy codes, including evaluations, must be billed as described in the billing instruction. Failure to bill correctly will result in denials or recoupment.
- Clarified under Provider Requirements/Documentation Requirements, that in addition to keeping individual medical records for each client, home agency providers must also report to OASIS (Medicare's Outcome and Assessment Information Set).
