- Volume XIV, Chapter 10, Conference Planning, discusses how and when VA emphasizes the need to plan conferences, including any associated travel. As defined by the Federal Travel Regulation (FTR), a conference may include a meeting, retreat, seminar, symposium or event that involves attendee travel.
- Volume XIV, Chapter 6, *International Travel*, establishes VA financial policies and procedures relating to international (foreign) travel. This chapter implements and supplements those portions of the FTR pertaining to foreign travel.
- Volume XIV, Chapter 9, Donated Travel, establishes VA financial policies and procedures relating to donated travel from non-Federal funding sources. These policies and procedures apply equally to both domestic and international travel.
- Volume XV, Chapter 1, Payroll: Overview, discusses VA financial policies and procedures regarding VA's payroll administration. VA's payroll operations include functions performed by VA employees as well as those performed by VA's Payroll Provider.
