**PARDON**

**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN**

**WHEREAS**, Larry J. Pitcock of Tompkinsville, Kentucky was convicted in 1996 of Theft by Unlawful Taking, Tampering with Physical Evidence, and Willful Failure to Pay Taxes in the Monroe Circuit Court; and

**WHEREAS**, all available evidence indicates that Larry J. Pitcock has led a law abiding and exemplary life since the time of his conviction; and

**WHEREAS**, Larry J. Pitcock has demonstrated that he is a useful member of society and of the community in which he resides and appears to be worthy of a full pardon:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Ernie Fletcher, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in consideration of the foregoing, and by the virtue of the authority vested in me by Sections 77, 145, and 150 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby unconditionally pardon Larry J. Pitcock and return to him all rights and privileges of a citizen of this Commonwealth.
