For several of these entries, I have noted corrections and additional information in a footnote. In some cases, there are discrepancies in the entries in Denissen for specific families. Marie Patnaude,³ ondoyée 7 July 1800 by Father Richard; buried 12 July 1800 in the cemetery

Alexis Boyer,⁴ [no age given], 25 July 1800, [burial location not specified]

Eléonore Thibault, 19 days, 28 July 1800, buried in cemetery

François Pelletier, son of Alexis Pelletier and Agathe Reaume;⁵⁷ one year, 24 October 1805, buried in cemetery

[Thérèse] Lelièvre, four years, 3 November 1805, buried in cemetery

- Antoine Créqui, son of Jean Baptiste Créqui and Cécile Meny; about seven years, 19 November 1805, buried in cemetery
- Therèse Béquet, wife of the deceased Isidore Chêne; about 60 years, 23 November 1805, buried in cemetery
- Catherine Reaume, wife of the deceased Robert Jeane; 65 years, 4 December 1805
- Isabelle Charron, wife of Antoine Descanelier; 68 years, 4 December 1805, buried in cemetery
- Pierre Brouillard, 100 years and a few months, 11 December 1805, buried in cemetery

Ambroise Tremblé,⁵⁸ about 50 years, 15 December 1805, buried in cemetery

⁵⁴ Husband of Catherine Charier. Joseph Voyer was baptized, 9 May 1737, at Québec [PRDH #17719].

⁵⁶ Possibly Antoine Jarlais *dit* St. Amand, son of Antoine Jarlais and Marie Angélique Billy *dite* St. Louis, baptized 10 November 1752 at Rivière-du-Loup (Louiseville). He married Marie Anne Lemaître, 7 January 1780, at Louiseville [PRDH #29506].

⁵⁷ Denissen, II, 951, #8, x – This is a difficult record to decipher. There is no baptism found for a François Peltier, born to Alexis Peltier and Agathe Réaume, in approximately October 1804. On a slip of paper, by Father Dilhet, there is the baptism on 22 January 1805 of François Peltier, son of the above couple, aged about $3-\frac{1}{2}$ months. His godfather was François Chartier. On 19 January 1805 Father Gabriel Richard buried "a child" of Alexis Peltier and Agathe Réaume. This unnamed child was about three months and had been *ondoyé* by Charles [Janson *dit*] Lapalme and had died on 16 January 1805. Finally, there is the above act of the burial of François Peltier, aged about one year. Possibly Alexis Peltier and Agathe Réaume were the parents of twins born *circa* October 1804?
