## BROILER EGGS SET IN 15 SELECTED STATES UP 3 PERCENT

Commercial hatcheries in the 15-State weekly program set 140 million eggs during the week ending March 23, 1991. This was 3 percent above the 136 million set the corresponding week a year earlier but 1 percent below the previous week. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week was 84 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set 3 weeks earlier.

## BROILER CHICKS PLACED UP 3 PERCENT

Broiler growers in the 15-State weekly program placed 114 million chicks for broiler production during the week ending March 23, 1991. Placements were 3 percent above placements for the comparable week in 1990 and 1 percent above the previous week. Cumulative placements from November 4, 1990, through March 23, 1991, were 2.16 billion, 3 percent above the 2.09 billion placed during the same period a year earlier.
