## Broiler Eggs Set In 15 Selected States Up 5 Percent

Commercial hatcheries in the 15-State weekly program set 142 million eggs during the week ending January 11, 1992. This was 5 percent above the 134 million eggs set the corresponding week a year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week was 84 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

## Broiler Chicks Placed Up 5 Percent

Broiler growers in the 15-State weekly program placed 115 million chicks for meat production during the week ending January 11, 1992. Placements were 5 percent above placements for the comparable week in 1991. Cumulative placements from November 3, 1991, through January 11, 1992, were 1.10 billion, 4 percent above the 1.05 billion placed during the same period a year earlier.
