Broiler Eggs Set In 15 Selected States Up 6 Percent

Commercial hatcheries in the 15-State weekly program set in incubators 156 million eggs during the week ending September 16, 1995. This was up 6 percent from the eggs set the corresponding week a year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week was 81 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler Chicks Placed Up Slightly

Broiler growers in the 15-State weekly program placed 129 million chicks for meat production during the week ending September 16, 1995. Placements were up slightly from the comparable week in 1994. Cumulative placements from October 30, 1994, through September 16, 1995, were 6.03 billion, 4 percent above the 5.79 billion placed during the same period a year earlier.
