## Broiler Eggs Set In 15 Selected States Up 3 Percent

Commercial hatcheries in the 15 -State weekly program set in incubators 177 million eggs during the week ending January 9, 1999. This was up 3 percent from the eggs set the corresponding week a year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week was 81 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

## Broiler Chicks Placed Up 6 Percent

Broiler growers in the 15 -State weekly program placed 145 million chicks for meat production during the week ending January 9, 1999. Placements were up 6 percent from the comparable week in 1998.
