## Broiler Eggs Set In 15 Selected States

## Down 2 Percent

Commercial hatcheries in the 15 -State weekly program set in incubators 171 million eggs during the week ending November 6, 1999. This was down 2 percent from the eggs set the corresponding week a year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week was 82 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

## Broiler Chicks Placed Down 2 Percent

Broiler growers in the 15-State weekly program placed 131 million chicks for meat production during the week ending November 6, 1999. Placements were down 2 percent from the comparable week in 1998. Cumulative placements from January 3, 1999, through November 6, 1999, were 6.28 billion, up 3 percent from the same period a year earlier.
