## Broiler-Type Eggs Set In 19 Selected States Up 3 Percent

Commercial hatcheries in the 19-State weekly program set 208 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 10, 2005. This was up 3 percent from the eggs set the corresponding week a year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week was 83 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

## Broiler Chicks Down 2 Percent

Broiler growers in the 19-State weekly program placed 171 million chicks for meat production during the week ending September 10, 2005. Placements were down 2 percent from the comparable week a year earlier. Cumulative placements from January 2, 2005 through September 10, 2005 were 6.32 billion, up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.
