Inspected Poultry - There was 1,287 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter by the United States Department of Agriculture during July 1975. This is 4 percent less than July 1974, but 9 percent above June 1975.

Young chickens inspected totaled 982 million pounds, 2 percent below July 1974, but 5 percent more than last month. Mature chickens inspected totaled 54.6 million pounds, 15 percent less than last year and 11 percent below June 1975. Total turkeys inspected at 243 million pounds were down 10 percent from a year ago, but up 39 percent from last month. Duck inspections at 7.5 million pounds were down 6 percent from July 1974 and 8 percent from the previous month.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in July totaled 947 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- down 3 percent from July 1974 but up 9 percent from last month. Of the July 1975 total, 76 percent was chilled and 24 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 179 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 14 percent from July 1974 and 18 percent above last month.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 266 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 8 percent from July 1974 and 4 percent more than the previous month.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during July were 5.2 million live weight. This was 0.40 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 0.67 percent a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 20.8 million pounds (NYD weight). This is 1.80 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 2.42 percent in July 1974.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (Including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during July 1975 was 967 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, down 3 percent from July 1974 but up 9 percent from last month.

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DEFINITIONS

YOUNG CHICKENS - COMMERCIALY GROWN BROILERS-FRYERS AND OTHER YOUNG IMMATURE BIRDS SUCH AS ROASTERS AND CAPONS.

MATURE CHICKENS - FOWL FROM BREEDER AND MARKET EGG FLOCKS AND STAGS AND COCKS.

FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - YOUNG IMMATURE BIRDS, USUALLY UNDER 16 WEEKS OF AGE.

YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - YOUNG BIRDS GROWN TO A MATURED MARKET AGE, USUALLY 5 TO 7 MONTHS.

OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - FULLY MATURED BIRDS HELD FOR EGG PRODUCTION, USUALLY OVER 15 MONTHS OF AGE.

DUCKS - INCLUDES ALL DUCKS REGARDLESS OF AGE AND WEIGHT.

OTHER POULTRY - INCLUDES ALL OTHER READY-TO-COOK PRODUCTS WHICH BEAR THE U.S.D.A. INSPECTED FOR WHOLESOMENESS LEGEND.
