LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS totaled 1.54 billion pounds during November 1979, up 5 percent from November 1978, but 19 percent below October 1979, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.13 billion pounds of young chickens, up 6 percent from November 1978, but 21 percent less than the previous month; 62.5 million pounds of mature chickens, 3 percent above the previous November live weight poundage but 28 percent below the October 1979 level. Turkey inspections totaled 330 million pounds, up 5 percent from the same month a year earlier, but a 12 percent decline from October 1979. Duck inspections at 8.40 million pounds decreased 4 percent from November 1978 and 23 percent below October 1979.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME, totaling 1.13 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight during November 1979, was up 5 percent from November 1978, but 19 percent below October 1979. The percentage breakdown for the November 1979 total is 76 percent chilled and 24 percent frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 275 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 6 percent from November 1978 but 18 percent below October 1979.

CUT-UP PACKAGED poultry products totaled 361 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, an increase of 2 percent from November 1978, but 9 percent below October 1979.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during November 1979 were 5.20 million pounds live weight. This was 0.33 percent of quantities inspected, the same percentage as a year ago. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS were 28.7 million pounds (N.Y.D. weight). This was 2.08 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 2.07 percent in November 1978.

POULTRY SLAUGHTERED (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during November was 1.14 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 5 percent from November 1978, but 19 percent below October 1979.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roasters turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
