

# POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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MAY 1980

LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS totaled 1.67 billion pounds during May 1980, down 1 percent from May 1979, but 3 percent greater than April 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.36 billion pounds of young chickens, down 3 percent from May 1979, but 1 percent above April 1980; 76.2 million pounds of mature chickens, slightly less than a year earlier and 15 percent below April 1980. Turkey inspections totaled 223 million pounds, up 13 percent from May a year ago and 25 percent above April 1980. Duck inspections at 9.26 million pounds were 6 percent below a year earlier, but 5 percent above April 1980.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME totaled 1.22 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight, slightly below May 1979, but 4 percent above April 1980. The May 1980 percentage breakdown was 82 percent chilled and 18 percent frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 256 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, 1 percent above May 1979 and 14 percent above April 1980.

CUT-UP PACKAGED poultry products totaled 474 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, a 14 percent increase from May 1979 and 22 percent above April 1980.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during May 1980 were 6.00 million pounds live weight. Percent of quantities inspected equaled 0.35 compared with 0.42 percent during May 1979. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS were 28.4 million pounds (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.89 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 2.05 percent during May 1979.

POULTRY SLAUGHTERED (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) was 1.23 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight, slightly below May 1979 but 4 percent above April 1980.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roasters turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.

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The data presented in this report were compiled from reports collected by the Meat and Poultry Inspection Program, Food Safety and Quality Service.
