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LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS totaled 1.41 billion pounds (638 thousand metric tons) during February 1981, down 2 percent from the 29 days in February 1980 and 13 percent below January 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.17 billion pounds (531 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, down 2 percent from February 1980 and 12 percent below January 1981; 76.7 million pounds (34.8 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, a decrease of 18 percent from a year earlier and 11 percent below January 1981. Turkey inspections totaled 152 million pounds (68.8 thousand metric tons), up 9 percent from the same month a year ago, but 15 percent below January 1981. Duck inspections at 6.91 million pounds (3140 metric tons) were 2 percent above February 1980, but 9 percent below January 1981.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME totaling 1.02 billion pounds (463 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during February 1981, declined 2 percent from February 1980 and 12 percent below January 1981. The percentage breakdown for the February 1981 total is 84 percent chilled and 16 percent frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 251 million pounds (114 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 2 percent from February 1980, but 12 percent below January 1981.

CUT-UP PACKAGED poultry products totaled 387 million pounds (175 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 6 percent from February 1980, but 9 percent below January 1981.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during February 1981 totaled 6.16 million pounds (2790 metric tons) live weight. Percent of quantities inspected equaled 0.43 for both February 1981 and 1980. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS were 27.4 million pounds (12.4 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight). This was 2.17 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 2.31 percent in February 1980.

POULTRY SLAUGHTER (including slaughter in non-federally inspected plants) during February 1981 was 1.03 billion pounds (466 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, down 2 percent from February 1980 and 12 percent below January 1981.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
