LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS totaled 1.79 billion pounds (814 thousand metric tons) during June 1981, up 9 percent from June 1980 and 5 percent above May 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.43 billion pounds (647 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, up 9 percent from June 1980 and 2 percent from May 1981; 74.0 million pounds (33.6 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, up 14 percent from a year earlier, but 4 percent below May 1981. Turkey inspections totaled 283 million pounds (128 thousand metric tons), up 10 percent from June a year ago and 26 percent above May 1981. Duck inspections of 11.4 million pounds (5170 metric tons) were 21 percent above June 1980 and 17 percent above May 1981.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME totaled 1.31 billion pounds (596 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during June 1981, an increase of 9 percent from June 1980 and 5 percent from May 1981. The percentage breakdown for June 1981 totals 79 percent chilled and 21 percent frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 287 million pounds (130 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 7 percent from June 1980 and 5 percent from May 1981.

CUT-UP PACKAGED poultry products totaled 472 million pounds (214 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 11 percent from June 1980, but 1 percent below May 1981.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during June totaled 8.44 million pounds (3830 metric tons) live weight. Percent of quantities inspected equaled 0.47 compared with 0.46 percent for June 1980. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 26.6 million pounds (12.1 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight). This was 1.65 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.80 percent in June 1980.

POULTRY SLAUGHTER (including slaughter in non-federally inspected plants) during June was 1.32 billion pounds (599 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 9 percent from June 1980 and 5 percent from May 1981.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
