

POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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Live Weight Poultry Inspections totaled 1.66 billion pounds (751 thousand metric tons) during April 1982, a decrease of 3 percent from April 1981 and 4 percent below March 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.38 billion pounds (625 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, down 3 percent from April 1981 and 4 percent below March 1982; 84.2 million pounds (38.2 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, a decrease of 7 percent from April 1981 and 1 percent below March 1982. Turkey inspections totaled 182 million pounds (82.8 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below April 1981 and 7 percent below March 1982. Duck inspections of 10.3 million pounds (4690 metric tons) were up 12 percent from April 1981 and up fractionally from March 1982.

Poultry Certified Wholesome totaled 1.21 billion pounds (551 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during April 1982, a decrease of 2 percent from April 1981 and 4 percent below March 1982. The percentage breakdown for the April 1982 total is 85 percent chilled and 15 percent frozen.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during April totaled 4.99 million pounds (2270 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations as a percent of quantities inspected was 0.30 percent compared with 0.31 percent for April 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 24.3 million pounds (11.0 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight). Quantities condemned equaled 1.63 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.90 percent during April 1981.

Further Processed poultry totaled 285 million pounds (129 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-Up packaged poultry products totaled 492 million pounds (223 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight.

Definitions Used to Report Federally Inspected Slaughter :

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.

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
