

POULTRY SLAUGHTER

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June 1982

Live Weight Poultry Inspections totaled 1.83 billion pounds (831 thousand metric tons) during June 1982, an increase of 1 percent from June 1981 and 10 percent above May 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.47 billion pounds (667 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, up 2 percent from June 1981 and 7 percent above May 1982, and 79.2 million pounds (35.9 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, an increase of 5 percent from June 1981 and 8 percent above May 1982. Turkey inspections totaled 270 million pounds (122 thousand metric tons), 5 percent below June 1981, but 32 percent above May 1982. Duck inspections of 12.3 million pounds (5570 metric tons) were up 7 percent from June 1981 and 17 percent above May 1982.

Poultry Certified Wholesome, during June 1982, totaled 1.35 billion pounds (613 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, an increase of 2 percent from June 1981 and 11 percent above May 1982. The percentage breakdown for June 1982 total is 82 percent chilled and 18 percent frozen.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during June totaled 5.47 million pounds (2480 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations of quantities inspected were 0.29 percent compared with 0.47 percent for June 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 23.7 million pounds (10.7 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. weight). Of the quantities inspected, 1.44 percent were condemned compared with 1.65 percent during June 1981.

Further Processed poultry totaled 294 million pounds (133 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-Up packaged poultry products totaled 508 million pounds (230 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight.

Definitions Used to Report Federally Inspected Slaughter.

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness Legend.

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
