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July 1982

Live Weight Poultry Inspections have a preliminary total of 1.75 billion pounds (795 thousand metric tons) during July 1982, a decrease of 3 percent from July 1981 and 5 percent below June 1982.

Inspections included 1.39 billion pounds (632 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, down 2 percent from July 1981 and 6 percent below June 1982; 64.6 million pounds (29.3 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, an increase of 2 percent from July 1981, but 20 percent below June 1982. Turkey inspections totaled 284 million pounds (129 thousand metric tons), 10 percent below July 1981, but 5 percent above June 1982. Duck inspections of 10.2 million pounds (4610 metric tons) were 4 percent below July 1981 and 17 percent below June 1982.

Poultry Certified Wholesome, during July 1982 totaled 1.30 billion pounds (589 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, a decrease of 3 percent from July 1981 and 5 percent below June 1982. The percentage breakdown for July 1982 total is 81 percent chilled and 19 percent frozen.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during July totaled 6.63 million pounds (3010 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations were 0.37 percent of the quantity inspected compared with 0.51 percent for July 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 23.2 million pounds (10.5 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. weight), 1.48 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.74 percent during July 1981.

Further Processed poultry totaled 334 million pounds (151 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-Up packaged poultry products totaled 515 million pounds (234 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
