The preliminary total of Live Weight Poultry Inspections was 1.76 billion pounds (798 thousand metric tons) for November 1984, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.35 billion pounds (613 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 61.1 million pounds (27.7 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 335 million pounds (152 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 10.9 million pounds (4940 metric tons) of ducks.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during November 1984 was 1.29 billion pounds (587 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Totals for October show that 1.60 billion pounds (724 thousand metric tons) were certified.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during November 1984 totaled 4.87 million pounds (2210 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.27 percent of the live weight inspected compared with 0.26 percent during November a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 26.7 million pounds (12.1 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), 1.69 percent of the quantities inspected compared with 1.55 percent a year earlier.

Further Processed poultry totaled 385 million pounds (175 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up packaged poultry totaled 602 million pounds (273 thousand metric tons).

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
