Our Mission

To improve the health of the people in the communities we serve.

Texas Health Resources is one of the largest faith-based, nonprofit health systems in the United States. The health system includes Texas Health Physicians Group and hospitals under the banners of Texas Health Presbyterian, Texas Health Arlington Memorial, Texas Health Harris Methodist and Texas Health Huguley. The system also includes outpatient facilities, freestanding ERs, home health and preventive and fitness services to provide the full continuum of care for all stages of life.

More than 23,000 employees of wholly owned/operated facilities plus 2,200 employees of consolidated joint ventures

Southwestern Health Resources

Southwestern Health is a clinically integrated network, formed in 2015, that brings together UT Southwestern Medical Center and Texas Health Resources to provide increased access to primary care and specialized care for the people of North Texas. Southwestern Health is made up of a 31-facility hospital network as well as an expansive network of physicians (UT Southwestern faculty, Texas Health employed, university-affiliated and independent) from both organizations.

Health plan

In 2016, Texas Health and Aetna created a jointly-owned health plan company, the first of its kind in North Texas, that focuses on improving quality, affordability and the overall consumer experience. By combining Texas Health's high-quality providers and investment in population health management with Aetna's health plan expertise, care management capabilities and analytical insights, employers and consumers in North Texas will benefit from more affordable, high-quality and better-coordinated care.
