## Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ending November 30, 1992, amounted to 722,951 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of November was 510,489 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 10,013,768 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles was 3,497,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 342,200 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(92)-11", dated December 23, 1992.
